ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).


Section 2.40(b)(2) - Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care. Each dealer or exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries.

- One elephant, Judy, had three open wounds on her forehead above the left eye and one open wound on the anterior distal portion of the left front leg. The wounds on the head were small, approximately 1/4 inch wide. The wound on the leg was approximately 1/4 inch wide by one inch long. The outer skin was gone revealing the underlying tissue. The underlying tissue was red. The handler of the elephants stated that the wounds were the result of using a powerwash on the animal that morning. The elephant was not under any medical treatment at the time of the inspection. Appropriate treatment must be administered and documentation must be maintained that includes the following information:

- Identity of the animal.
- Descriptions of the illness or injury
- Dates, details, and results of examinations, tests, and other such procedures.
- Dates and other details of all treatments, including the name, dose, route, frequency, and duration of treatment with drugs or other medications

This affects one animal.

This inspection was conducted by the licensee, Jan Feldman, Animal Care Inspector, and Jeff Baker, Veterinary Medical Officer, at the Shrine Circus in Springfield, MO.
