Only one animal handler was available to manage two elephants providing rides to the public. There were times when both elephants were loaded with public and the handler was not in the ring with the animals and could not have been in control of either elephant. No other knowledgeable and experienced elephant handler was available to assist this handler during public exhibition.

Dangerous animals must be under direct control and supervision of a knowledgeable and experienced animal handler during public exhibition.
